Foods & Nutrition entries must have been made by the exhibitor, NO MIXES; must be in the quantities and sizes specified in Premium Book; foods that require refrigeration cannot be entered; pies must be on aluminum pie plates, all other items on white paper plates or heavy cardboard and covered with plastic bags, except breads may be in plastic bags only.
2. Decorated Cakes and Other Decorated Items must be freshly decorated.
3. Quantities – Muffins, biscuits, rolls, cookies, candies – one half dozen; Cakes – 1/2 cake plus enough for one slice that judge will remove; Bread – 1/2 loaf; Monster Cookies, Popcorn Balls, Candied Apples – two.

4. All Foods & Nutrition entries will be disposed of at the close of the Fair. Only Table Settings, ribbons, and checks are to be picked up.
5. Management has the right to remove/or dispose of food items if they deteriorate during the Fair.
6. Limits – Eight (8) different exhibits, each to be listed separately and identified by name on entry form (Example: banana bread, sugar cookies, chocolate fudge, etc.).

3. Paintings & drawings must be mounted or matted on heavy paper or cardboard, and not larger than 16" x 20". NO FRAMES OR GLASS ALLOWED. Must be labeled on the back with division number, class number and exhibitor's name.
4. Pre-cut or Pre-stamped items must have a note attached stating which portion of the exhibit was completed by the exhibitor.
5. Management will use every precaution within its power for the safe preservation of all exhibits, but WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE to any exhibit. Exhibitors wishing insurance coverage must arrange for their own insurance.
6. All exhibits must be in good taste, suitable for family viewing, or may be subject to removal by management .
