CEO Ales reports that non-fair events are going to be more aggressive than before, specifically the crab feed. CEO Ales states that the Association is taking back the responsibility of hosting the 4<sup>th</sup> of July festivities.

#### Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition (1) 9/30/25 \$161.7 billion

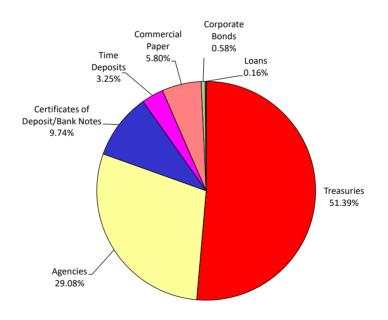

However, if the 13-week Daily Treasury Bill Rate on the last day of the fiscal year is below 1%, then administrative costs shall not exceed 8% of quarterly EARNINGS of the fund for the subsequent fiscal year.
